

Release, Waiver of Liability and Indemnity Agreement

In consideration of the undersigned's child(ren) being permitted to participate in horseback riding, swimming, ropes course events and any related activities, the undersigned, for themselves, their child(ren), their personal representatives, assigns heirs, and next of kin – acknowledges and agrees as follows:

- 1) The undersigned hereby releases, waives, discharges and agrees not to sue The Bar 717 Ranch, Inc., the participants, the sanctioning organization or any subdivision thereof, promoters, sponsors, advertisers, owners and lessees of premises used to conduct the event and each of them, their officers, directors, agents, representatives, and employees, all for the purposes herein referred to as “releases”, from all liability to the undersigned, their child(ren), assigns, heirs and next of kin for any and all loss, damage, claims or demands therefor on account of injury, including death, to the child(ren) or property competing, officiating in, observing, working for, or for any purpose participating in the event.
- 2) The undersigned releases or otherwise holds harmless the Bar 717 Ranch, Inc. while his or her child(ren) compete, officiate, observe, or work for, or for any purpose participate in the event.
- 3) The undersigned expressly acknowledges and agrees that the activities can involve the risk of injury, including death. The undersigned further expressly agrees that the forgoing release, waiver of liability, and indemnity agreement is intended to be as broad and inclusive as is permitted by the law of the State of California.
- 4) The undersigned has read and voluntarily signs the release, waiver of liability and indemnity agreement, and further agrees that no oral representations, statements or inducements apart from the forgoing written agreement have been made.
- 5) The undersigned will not hold the Bar 717 Ranch Inc. responsible for any accidental injury that might occur during this program.
