RECOMMENDED CLOTHING AND EQUIPMENT LIST**

Each article of clothing and equipment must be plainly marked with your camper's name. We recommend indelible ink, felt-tipped marking pen or laundry marking pen. They work much better than tape and are easier to read. Please mark clothing in a visible place to help our laundry personnel. If your child values their clothing and equipment, it **MUST** be marked with their name so we can return it to them if it is misplaced. Elaborate mountaineering and camping equipment and clothing is not necessary for camp. Middle price range articles are very adequate. Camper's should bring practical clothing that they will not be reluctant to get dirty. Your camper's clothing should not preclude his/her ability and desire to become fully involved in all aspects of camp life.

Each camper's laundry is done once a week. Please have your camper(s) travel light. A duffel bag, carry on bag, and sleeping bag should be sufficient for every camper. **Please do not pack in trunks or suitcases. Please use a duffel bag.**

RECOMMENDED FOR BOTH GIRLS AND BOYS

CLOTHING

- 4 pairs shorts
- 4 pairs long pants
- 8 T-shirts or tank tops
- 1 warm jacket
- 3 long-sleeved warm shirts and/or sweatshirts
- (for girls-optional) 2 dance-night dresses or skirts
- 2 pair pajamas
- 2 swim suits
- 2 pair sturdy shoes with extra laces
- 1 pair sturdy hiking boots or work boots already broken in
- 10 pair socks
- 1 hat or sun visor
- 1 day pack
- 8 pair underwear
- Riding helmet (NO bicycle helmets)
- Water shoes for river walking

EQUIPMENT

- 1 stuffable sleeping bag
- 1 blanket
- 1 pillow
- 2 pillow cases
- 1 laundry bag
- 2 bath towels
- 1 beach towel
- 1 wash cloth
- 1 flashlight with 1 extra set of batteries
- 1 soap box with soap
- 1 water bottle (quart size)
- 1 whistle
- writing paper, pens and pencils
- stamped envelopes and post cards
- toiletries (hair brush and comb, shampoo and conditioner, toothbrush, lotion, sunscreen, chapstick, feminine hygiene products if necessary)
- backpack - for campers interested in backpacking

OPTIONAL

Camera with plenty of film. Insect repellent. Musical instrument. Fishing gear for trout. Plain T-shirts for silk-screening.

OPTIONAL EQUIPMENT LIST FOR EXTENDED BACKPACKING TRIPS

This list is provided as a suggestion for campers who may be interested in extended backpacking trips. We realize that much of this gear can be expensive and encourage you to borrow, or, if necessary purchase from surplus or second hand stores.

Highly Recommended

- durable internal or external frame backpack (2500 cu. inches or more)
- hiking boots (already worn in, good ankle support)
- mid-weight synthetic long underwear (top and bottom)
- wool/synthetic hat
- wool/synthetic top
- wool/synthetic bottom
- 2 pair wool/synthetic socks
- stuffable sleeping bag
- insulating ground pad
- water bottle (32 oz)

Recommended

- sunglasses
- synthetic sock liners
- tarp or packable rain gear
