RECOMMENDED CLOTHING AND EQUIPMENT LIST

Please mark each article of clothing and equipment clearly with your camper's name. We recommend indelible ink, felt-tipped marking pen or laundry marking pen. They work much better than tape and are easier to read. Please mark clothing in a visible place to help our laundry personnel. All of your child's clothing and equipment must be marked with their name so we can return it to them if it is misplaced. Elaborate mountaineering and camping equipment and clothing is not necessary for camp. Campers should bring practical clothing that they will not be reluctant to get dirty. Your camper's clothing should not preclude their ability and desire to become fully involved in all aspects of camp life.

Each camper's laundry is done once a week. Please have your camper(s) travel light. A duffel bag, carry on bag, and sleeping bag should be sufficient for every camper. Please do not pack in trunks or suitcases, please use a duffel bag.
